

Community Action Kentucky's Rural Community Assistance Program (RCAP) has been selected by USDA Rural Development to provide Leadership Development classes through the Rural Community Development Initiative.

"These grants help people attract and retain investments in rural communities," Agriculture Under Secretary for Rural Development Thomas C. Dorr said. "They fund entrepreneurship training, leadership development and other efforts to help business and community leaders expand their local economies and create jobs."

Kentucky RCAP will train leaders in six low-income communities on four training modules: Understanding Leadership, Communicating Effectively, Building Communities through Collaboration, and Leading Community Change.
